

Adidas Miteam - Guide

Step 1 – Register yourself on the Adidas Miteam Page - <http://www.miteam.adidas.co.nz/>

Step 2 – Find your product

At the top of the page hover over either Mens, womens or youth and under sports select 'More Sports'

Step 3 – Select the product that you want to customise

Uniform garments = climacool (This Team16 uniform is made with ventilating climacool® to keep you feeling cool and dry no matter how hard you play. Made of earth-friendly recycled polyester, this kit is ready for your signature with custom colours and details.)

Team garments = climalite (This Team16 Tee/Polo is made with Climalite® to keep you feeling cool and dry on sideline. Made of earth-friendly recycled polyester. Get your short ready for the season by adding team colours and personalised details.)

From here select your product that you want to customise. When you are in this area you will have a toolbar on the side which will let you customise the Shape, upper and lower pieces of the garment (Shirt and jackets only), side panel & cuff, stripes and the Logo. During this customisation process you can alter the colour options through almost every panel of the garment. You can also change the position of the Adidas Logo and add or remove the "3 stripes".

Step 4 – Personalisation Options

When you have finished customising the product you will then be given the option of personalising the garment. Using the various options (Below) on the side bar you can then make personalise the garments.

- Team Name
 - Player Name
 - Number
 - Artwork/Graphics
 - For each of the above options you may be able to choose:
 - Application options
 - Font type
 - Arc type (for letters only, numbers will always be straight)
 - Size
 - Colours (one or two colours – depending on the app type and if you choose an outline or not)
- Application options** Generally Adidas offers the following application options, which can differ depending on the sports category and product:
- Heat transfer
 - Screen print
 - Embroidery

Step 5 – Review your design

When you have finished configuring your mi Adidas product you can review your design by clicking on "I'm done customising". The summary page will show you all the details that you have chosen during your configuration.

The summary page will also allow you to print the product summary by clicking on the "print" button on the bottom-right corner. You can then save your design in order to review it later.

Step 6 – Completing the order

After you have finalised your product configuration you can click on "I'm done customising". This will take you to your design summary. Afterwards click on "add to order" so that the design can be added to a new or existing order. You will be prompted in a pop-up window to choose either "Create a new order" or "Add to existing order". Once you select your preference, you will be taken to an "order summary" page.

If you are satisfied with the order summary, you can click "complete this order" to be taken to a new section where you can finalise the order and submit it to a retailer.

In this option select TEAMSPO RTS. If you or your customer does not do this they will be paying the full retail prices that are quoted on the website.

Step 7 – Upload Images

If you have Adidas-approved custom artwork/graphics (see [*Personalisation Options*](#) for the approval process), you will need to provide Teamsports with a vectorized PDF* (.pdf) or Adobe Illustrator file (.ai) of your graphic. This is necessary to get the best possible print quality on your customised products. If you do not have custom artwork, you can forego this step by clicking the "**skip this step**" button.

Step 8 – Complete Order - Final

After choosing Teamsports you will be asked to complete your order. This will then submit the order through to Teamsports to review.

Once this is done Teamsports will contact you to confirm the prices and details of your order as well as a deposit to confirm your order.
